The Boeger Leadership Lodge main level has a large great hall, tables & chairs, large video projector screen, a comfortable lounge area by the fireplace, full commercial kitchen and restrooms. The lower level has 4 bunkhouses with bunk beds to sleep 42 people, showers, restrooms, linens & laundry. The Lodge will be used for Blackhawk Area Council's NYLT (National Youth Leadership Training) course as well as Woodbadge C-16-10 this year. Also available to interested groups will be a full Leadership Curriculum suitable for middle school youth, either scouts or non-scouts, in a 2-day 3-night program. The building itself will also be available for non-scouting use, as the schedule permits.
